Want to Change Something?

- Maybe you want a stop sign on your corner.
- Maybe you think college should be free.
- Maybe you are concerned about teens being harassed by the police.

Lobbying the Right Government

- Understand which level of government controls the thing you'd like to change
- Ask an elected official who represents you (or their staff person)

Know Your "Ask"

Should the official:

- Contact someone to support your point?
- Support your idea in committee?
- Sponsor a law?
- Vote for a particular law?
- Support funding for your idea?
- Get information for you?

Have the Facts

- Clearly explain the problem
- Have some relevant statistics
- Outline solutions you support
- Don't make anything up
- If you don't know an answer that the official asks, promise to get back to him/her. Then do that!



Listen

- Hear the official's point of view
- Ask clarifying questions

Be Polite and Show Respect

- Never call the official any demeaning name
- Thank them for listening
- Thank them for the time they have given you
- Send a written thank-you in which you again mention any points that have been agreed on.
